Brethren and Ladies,

What our new partnership with Fresno State for the RiteCare Childhood Language Center of Fresno means...

- 1. From the outside looking in this is a change in who we are contracting with as our independent consultant for the delivery of services from Sunrise, Speech Pathology Corp to Fresno State.
- 2. We will be able to reduce our annual operating cost from the current amount of approximately \$135,000 per year to \$50,000 per year for the first two years and \$75,000 for the third year. That's a 63% cost reduction in the first two years from our current level and a 44% decrease for year three.
- 3. The initial agreement with Fresno State will be for three years.
- 4. Through this partnership we will also be able to increase the number of children in our program from approximately 24 at any given time to approximately 72-76 at any given time. This is an increase of approximately 300% in the number of children we can help in the community.
- 5. And we will have naming rights for their SLP graduate program (pending Fresno State final approval) which will be Fresno Scottish Rite Childhood Language Program.

#### THE DIVINE FEMININE

#### THE SOUL OF MAN

Masonry is oftentimes referred to as Feminine, as we frequently refer to the Teachings as "Her teachings". This is done much in the same way as we refer to the Earth as Feminine, for we call her Mother Earth. This is done, again, in reference to Nature, or more commonly known as Mother Nature.

With the Earth, it is due to the fact we emerged from it into a species. With Nature, it is because she is birther of all things we see, they always coming from Nature. With Freemasonry, She gives birth to every Mason, and Her teachings give birth to new understandings and vistas of Life. Do we not call our Blue Lodge our Mother Lodge? But there is hidden in this a beautiful esoteric teaching about the constitution of Man and how he should address his Three-Fold Nature of being.

Man is Three-Fold in the sense that he is Body, Mind, and Spirit, or Body, Soul, and Spirit. The relationship between Mind and Soul is quite extensive, but for sake of simplicity, it should be understood that no Thought can exist without a Space for it to inhabit. The Mind immediately provides the Space for the Thought to exist in, and no man can think a thought without it inhabiting some form of Space. This makes the Mind *Receptive* to Ideas, or in other words, the Mind *Receives* the Idea and gives it Form in Space.

The Soul is the envelope of the Divine Spark, more commonly known as the Spirit. This Spirit is Life, and the Soul is the "holder" of this infant Spirit, as is shown symbolically with Isis holding Horus, Mary holding Jesus, Maya holding Buddha, or any other religious Madonna and Child. This makes the Soul *Feminine* in Nature and the Spirit *Masculine*.

To explain this concept, the Mystery of the Holy Grail will be explained. The Grail is the Vessel, as its form suggests, and the Man (the Ego) is the valiant Knight in search of his Beloved, which is symbolized by the Holy Grail. The Knight "goes in search" of his Beloved, risking everything to find Her. During his search, he must "divest himself" of all that is unworthy of Her, thus making himself a Pure and Illuminated Man.

His Beloved, or Grail, is symbolically his Soul, and he takes the place of the Spirit in search of Union with it. His divestment symbolizes the Purification of the Man and his Ego, removing all that is base and unworthy of a Bride as gorgeous as Her. She will only "go with him" if he has proven himself, which symbolizes that Man is incapable of comprehending (Seeing) the Mysteries unless his mind is purified of all that is base and unclean. Then, and only then, will the Mystery unfold itself to Man, and this is done with no effort once the Space has been made clean. Much in the same way that a seed requires no prompting to begin its growth, so it is with the Spirit unifying with its Soul, they naturally unifying once the conditions are made right. In order to do this, Man must Seek his Bride with Love, Care, and Compassion. Is it any different when we seek our Lover in the material world? Do we not put our best foot forward when we court our personal Beloved? Fortunately for us, the Soul is not fooled by the bolstering and pomp of a boy, but seeks the company of a True and Righteous Man.

In Freemasonry, this is hidden under the concept of Light, as the unification of the Spirit and Soul is the Enlightenment and Illumination of the whole being of Man, thus making him Radiant. This is also taught in the manner we address our Beloveds, and our teachings place special emphasis on our conduct towards them. In each of these aspects Man is taught to be better to all that is Feminine in Nature, and through this emerges the Beauty of Love in our immediate lives. The way you Love your Beloved is a direct reflection of how you Love your Soul, for they are the physical embodiment of the internal quality of your being. Like the Knight in search of his Beloved, I am sure you would risk just as much for the ones you Love. I ask, Are you giving the same attention to your Spiritual Lover known as your Soul? Is She not also worthy of your admiration and affection? Your own Soul awaits you in the Bridal Chamber of the Heart!
