FIRST CARE OF THE LODGE TILING THE MIND OF MAN

In the beginning of our Masonic Journey, we are shown the "workings" of the Lodge. This is done in the closing of our 1st Degree, after we are seated amongst the Brethren. This task is performed by the Junior Deacon of the Lodge when he is asked, "What is the First and Last care of a Lodge?", as it is he who informs the Tiler that we are about to close and directs him to perform his Duty. This Duty takes on an entirely new meaning when the symbolism of the Lodge is directed inward, which is to say, when the Freemason discovers that the Lodge is a metaphor for himself and his actions in Life.

There are as many parts of Man's being that this analogy can be applied to as there are thorough understandings of Knowing thy Self. But, for the purpose of this work, it will be applied to the Brother's Thoughts, Words, and Deeds. This will demonstrate how the Tiler becomes the safeguard of his Secret (Silent) Workings of his own "Temple not built by hands."

As Thought precedes both Word & Deed, it would logically dictate that the Mind of the Brother must be Tiled. By doing this, the Brother "observes the approach" of the Thoughts not worthy of admission into the Temple that is his Mind and being "armed with the proper implement" of Truth (symbolized by the Sword), he bars their admittance. This, in one way, means that we must only allow thoughts worthy of our consideration, which is to say, those which work to our betterment. Simply put, they must be Constructive Thoughts. We are "Building" a Temple after all.

This leads us to our Spoken Words, they being the expression and manifestation of the Thoughts of Man. If the Tiler of the Mind is on guard and is instructed on who is allowed to pass, then Words of Love, Affection, and Compassion become our native language, especially to those who are desirous of such from us. Words not being enough, as "faith without works is Dead (inert)", these Thoughts that have proved their worthiness were allowed to enter and "take part of the rights and privileges" of our Actions. This demonstrates the need for Constructive Thoughts, as they become the Workers behind our Actions, which is to say, our Deeds.

Our Deeds reflect our character far more than Words ever could, which allows all Brethren to "know a Tree by its Fruit". Knowing that the Body follows the Mind, it becomes immediately self-evident the importance of Tiling the Mind, and why Truth and Virtue become the "passwords" of admittance into our personal Lodge. By being ever watchful, not allowing any to "pass or repass" without our permission, you can set your "Craft to work" for the betterment of your own Mind, Body, and Soul, a Trinity manifested in the Fruits of your Character, as this is demonstrated by your Deeds. I repeat, "You shall know them by their Fruits."

Now it should be clear as to why that is the "most important care of a Lodge," and why the oftentimes unnoticed (Hidden/Secret) chair becomes the most important. It should also be clear as to why he is armed with a Sword, instrument of Truth and Justice, as it is Truth the separates the worthy from the profane, and it is Justice that keeps them out by the enforcement of the Will of the Mind.

My Beloved Brethren, nothing in our Degrees or Ceremonies is by chance or accident, and oftentimes the least noticed are the most important. Each carries a profoundly deeper meaning when the symbolism is directly applied to YOU.

Book of the month: *The Ancient & Accepted Scottish Rite Of Freemasonry* By Charles Sumner Lobingier, 33°
